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2023 PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS


We facilitated 20 programs this year for the community which includes in person connection events for children, Caregiver Nights, & virtual zooms for parents. We launched a national diaversary card program to mail cards to people with TID on the anniversary of their diagnosis. This fall we ran a pilot for a college kit program, mailing care packages to college students with TID living away from home. We supported Camp Pathfinder with snacks and goody bags, continuing to work with CCMC, JDRF, Lions Club & Meriden YMCA on this program. We also distributed bags of gluten free groceries for celiac awareness month and a large clothing donation to families in need. We continue to support JDRF & CCMC programs that help our TID community.

> Program Highlight: 75 members of our T1D community were granted a wish day at Legoland NY thanks to a partnership between Merlin's Magic Wand Foundation & Elbowbumpkid Inc. Merlin's Magic Wand provided the families with tickets and parking. Elbowbumpkid Inc sponsored two snack breaks for the T1D children. Legoland New York also ensured each T1D child had Reserve Ride access so no child was sidelined by treating their diabetes.



SCHOLARSHIPS

We continued to provide a partial scholarship for the Friends for Life education event, supporting 3 families in 2023. We established a scholarship committee to redesign the application & outline new parameters for 2024 subsidies.

BOARD & OVERHEAD


